Objective: establishing, maintaining and applying a community based model of social service delivery to implement the Vision/Kaupapa

Infrastructure:

- (a) Office premises-** as a physical presence and base to coordinate the activities listed below; a place where people can come when in need, or with assistance for others.
- (b) Website-** as a facility for promotion, education and relationship building functions set out below,
- (c) Administrator –** to occupy and co-ordinate (a) and (b).

Methods:

- (a) Identify all groups and individuals in Napier City undertaking local health, welfare, educational and other similar community based initiatives.
- (b) Identify potential sources of funding for such initiatives;
- (c) Build relationships with funding agencies, Councils , iwi groups, other bodies with statutory responsibilities for social wellbeing;
- (d) Promote awareness of the Trust as a vehicle, conduit, facilitator, source of guidance and support for the type of initiatives in (a).
- (e) Raise media profile of the trust and its core beliefs (the kauapapa , transformative action etc)
